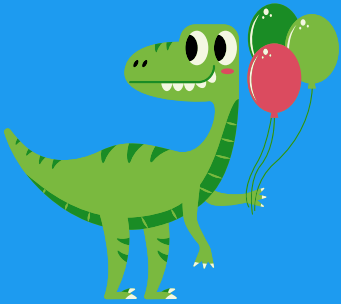

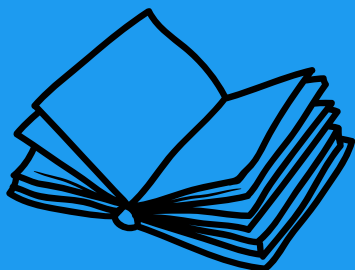

We will be having a Harvest Festival assembly on Wednesday 19th October. If you would like to donate any tins or non perishables please bring them in and give them to your class teachers.

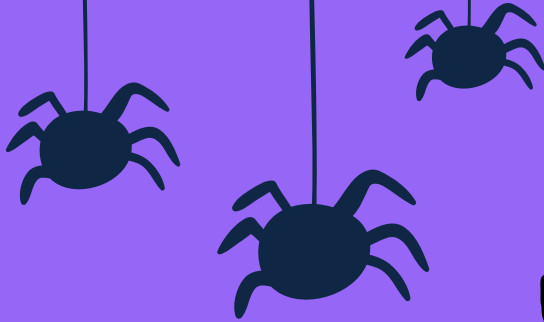
