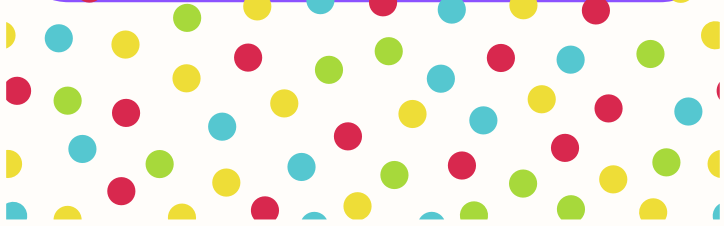


# Parent notices



**There will be no Rockets Friday 16th December and school will close at 2pm for the christmas break.**

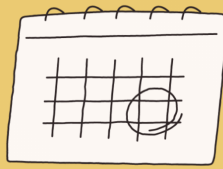
**For children in need this year your child can wear something spotty on Friday 18th November.**
