



You may be aware that the Department for Education has recently announced national changes to penalty notices issued for unauthorised absence in term time. These changes came into effect on 19th August 2024. These changes will have a particular impact for families who take their child out of school each year for a family holiday.

The changes to be aware of are:

Penalty notices issued for offences that take place after 19 August 2024 will be charged at a new rate of £160 per parent per child. This can be paid at £80 if paid within 21 days.

Any second penalty notice issued to the same parent/s for the same child within a rolling 3-year period will be issued at the rate of £160 to be paid within 28 days with no option for a reduced rate for early payment. The threshold at which a penalty notice must be considered is set at 10 sessions (equivalent to 5 days) of unauthorised absence within a rolling 10-school week period. This may include absences as a result of arriving late after the register closes. A maximum of 2 penalty notices may be issued to a parent for the same child within a rolling 3-year period. At the 3rd (or subsequent) offence(s) another course of action will need to be considered (such as prosecution). Only penalty notices issued for absences taking place after 19 August 2024 will count towards the above thresholds.

This is a national policy which is being driven across all schools. The money collected from the fixed penalty notice does not come into the school budget and the fine is not issued by us however we are duty bound to report the absence to the Local Authority.

If you are considering booking a holiday in term time, please do contact us to discuss this prior to booking. This would give us an opportunity to discuss further the impact that this may have on your child's learning and development.
